

NE Anthony Henday: North Saskatchewan River twin bridges



Currently under construction

- Southside berm to build piers
- Ongoing pier and abutment substructure work
- Girder installation
- Ongoing earthworks
- Extensive flood reparation work after June berm breach

Environmental considerations

- In-stream construction to occur when it is least disruptive to fish
- Radio-tagging of fish to monitor their navigation of in-water construction areas
- Turbidity monitoring downstream to identify possible adjustments in construction methods and minimize impact on fish

Open to the public in 2016

- Two bridges over the North Saskatchewan River
- Four lanes for southbound traffic
- Three lanes for northbound traffic
- Pedestrian bridge suspended below southbound bridge
